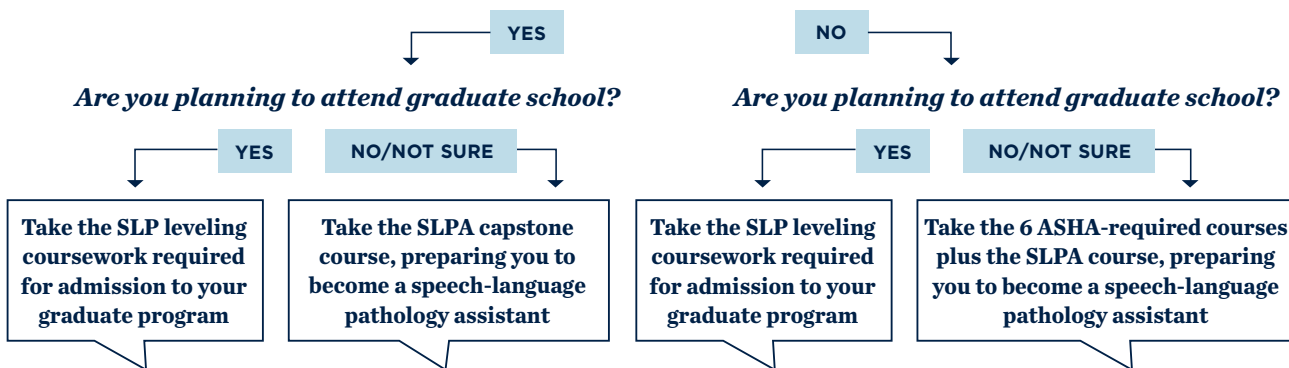


COURSES AT A GLANCE
