AT A GLANCE

We offer the support and coursework your provisionally licensed teachers need to fulfill the VDOE requirements for a Virginia Teaching License.

This initiative offers individualized, dedicated support for each provisionally licensed teacher in your school division through a licensure completion plan developed based on their VDOE Evaluation Letter. It outlines the courses needed and when they should be taken, as well as advising and coaching for each teacher by one of our staff.

We work closely with your personnel office to provide progress reports and updates that will help you ensure your provisionally licensed teachers become licensed.

REQUIREMENTS

- If you hold a bachelor's degree, we'll request your most recent degree transcript as part of the online application.
- Participants must hold a current teaching position and a current Provisional license.

LICENSURE REGULATIONS

Our coursework aligns with the Virginia Licensure Regulations to meet VDOE requirements.

TUITION AND FEES

Based on current tuition rates, tuition is \$295* per credit. Our courses are three credits. There are no additional fees. This rate does not include textbooks. The University offers a monthly payment plan option.

These rates are lower than our regular graduate tuition. For large groups, we may be able to offer an additional discount.
